Guidelines:

- 1. Artwork must align with at least one of Healthy House's four principles:
 - a. Healthy eating
 - b. Healthy living
 - c. Environmental equity
 - d. Environmental education
- 2. No restriction on size, but...
 - a. Artwork must fit through our front door.
 - b. Artwork must be able to hang from the supports provided by Louisville Grows. Nails cannot be used to hang artwork.
 - c. Artwork cannot be intrusive or block pathway in hallway gallery.

To Proceed:

- 1. Request and complete the Artist Submission Form and email it to programs@louisvillegrows.org
 - a. Submit with "HH Art Submission" as subject line.

If Artist Submission Form is accepted, you will be notified by Louisville Grows' Outreach Coordinator. A meeting will be set up to determine the date of exhibit, number of art pieces and establish a timeline for installation at Healthy House.
